MIHCA Update October 2023 Sad news; the BIG Ask; the Next 'Poke'

Sad news: We are sorry to report that Leanne Rowand, Nurse Practitioner at the Health Centre clinic, is leaving her position effective October 1, 2023. We congratulate her on the exciting new opportunities she is following and are so very grateful for the care she has provided Mayne Islanders over many years.

While Island Health is seeking a replacement, more Mayne Islanders will be left without primary health care. In partnership with Dr. Losier, our Association is actively lobbying and encouraging Island Health to expedite their recruitment efforts as well as arrange for interim coverage until a permanent replacement is hired. We encourage everyone to please be patient as we await the outcome of our efforts. As a reminder, in an emergency always call 911.

We are advocating for the current part-time Nurse Practitioner position to be increased to a full time position, as a means to expand access to primary health care on Mayne. We are also advocating for additional part time Physician coverage at the Health Centre which, combined with a full time Nurse Practitioner, would make for a very significant improvement in accessing primary healthcare on Mayne.

Of course there is a big difference between us advocating and Island Health agreeing, but we are working with a number of influential partners in an effort to make this happen - It is the cornerstone of our 3-year strategic plan.
