News from a recent meeting with our Island Health Leadership Team: With Dr. Losier's support and advocacy, our joint messaging to Island Health (IH) is generating action. We are pleased to report that IH has now posted a full time Nurse Practitioner position for our Health Centre, replacing Leanne Rowand (DNP), who was part time.

IH is also open to our seeking additional Family Physician coverage and is increasing the hours of the current RN position. We'll be promoting both the Nurse Practitioner and Family Physician opportunities in MIHCA's new recruitment video to be released in November. The video will be shared nationally through Doctors of BC.

Coincidentally, Canadian health ministers have green-lit a new cross-Canada licensing system for physicians and nurses that will facilitate more inter-provincial movement with fewer barriers. We're hoping this new licensing system will make it easier to attract medical personnel to Mayne Island.

Although we have challenges ahead and it will take time to recruit resources, we're over the first hurdle: IH's acknowledgement and support of our needs.

In the meantime, here are two useful links as possible interim access points to reach a family physician and or specialist.

CanScreenBC is the first clinic dedicated exclusively to cancer screening in BC, offering publicly funded cancer screening to all BC residents who don't have a primary care physician. <u>canscreenbc.com/</u>
