A significant number of part-time residents and visitors add to the population on weekends and during the summer months.

Central Hub of Community Support

The Clinic is part of the Mayne Island Health Centre, which offers complementary health services such as community and public health nursing, lab specimen collection, physio and massage therapy, chiropractic care and mental health counselling.

Situated next to the Health Centre, the BC Ambulance Service is available 24/7.

Our state-of-the-art firehall complements this hub of emergency support.



Clinic Waiting Room and Front Office Reception

Patients are welcomed to a bright and spacious area surrounded by natural light and soothing music.



Our exceptional team of Medical Office Assistants has many years of experience supporting our health care providers and our diverse cross-section of patients – from young to aging members of our community.

In small rural settings like ours, MOAs play an integral role liaising between health care providers and our patients.



Treatment Room

This bright, large, very well-equipped Treatment Room supports everything needed to work in major and minor emergencies – very similar to a hospital ER and under the guidance and standards of Island Health.

Bedside Clarius US is available for Emergencies and Clinic iPad with direct RTVS RUDi connection.

Access to the Helipad and BC Ambulance Services is only steps away. Patient transport by air, depending on weather, can be 20 min to Victoria or by Water Ambulance alternative 1-2 hours.

Several regular ferry connections a day are available as well.



Minor Treatment Room

This room has multiple purposes and is often used as a secondary urgent care or provider exam room.

It is used frequently for dressing changes, patient triage, home care clients, biopsies or other minor procedures.

It is a flexible, multi-functional complement to our overall space.



Medications and Supply Room

There is no Pharmacy on the Island and the nearest one is in Sidney. We do have a local courier providing prescription pick up and delivery service three times per week.

The Clinic has a wide selection of necessary sample medications such as antibiotics, gastro-intestinal, respiratory and other medications a patient might need until a full prescription can be filled.

There are also no X-Ray services available on Mayne. Lab is available once a week.

A private and confidential space where patients are seen in a professional and relaxing atmosphere surrounded with evidence-based, personalized holistic care.



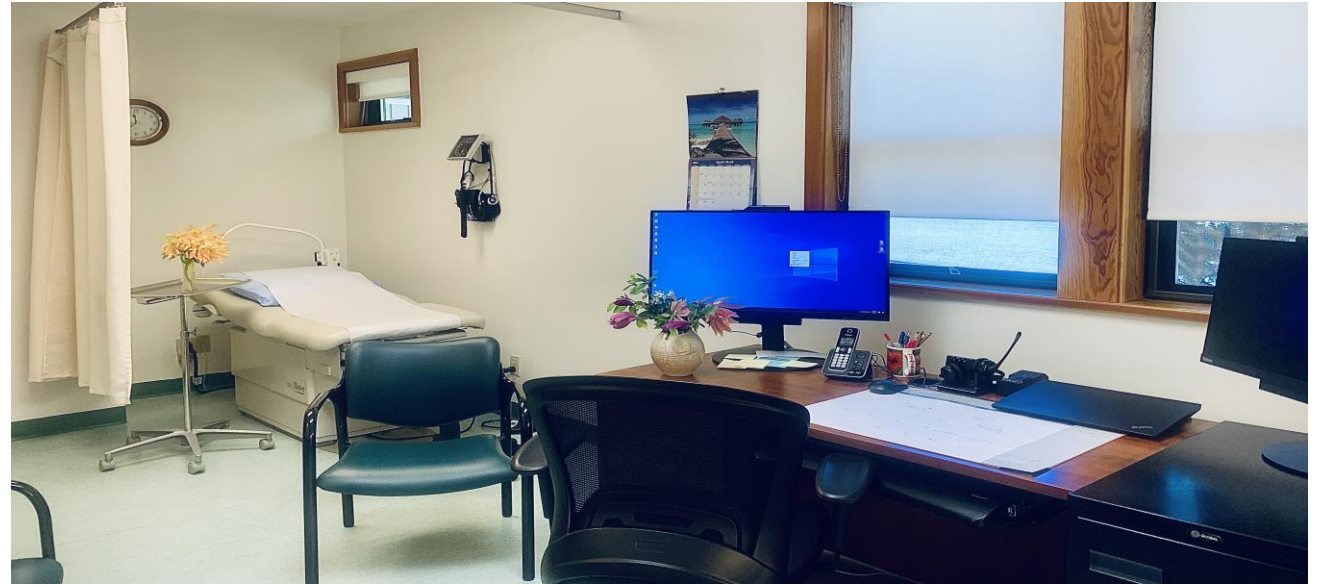
New Primary Care Provider's Office and Exam Room

Secondary Provider spaces are also available for an additional use.



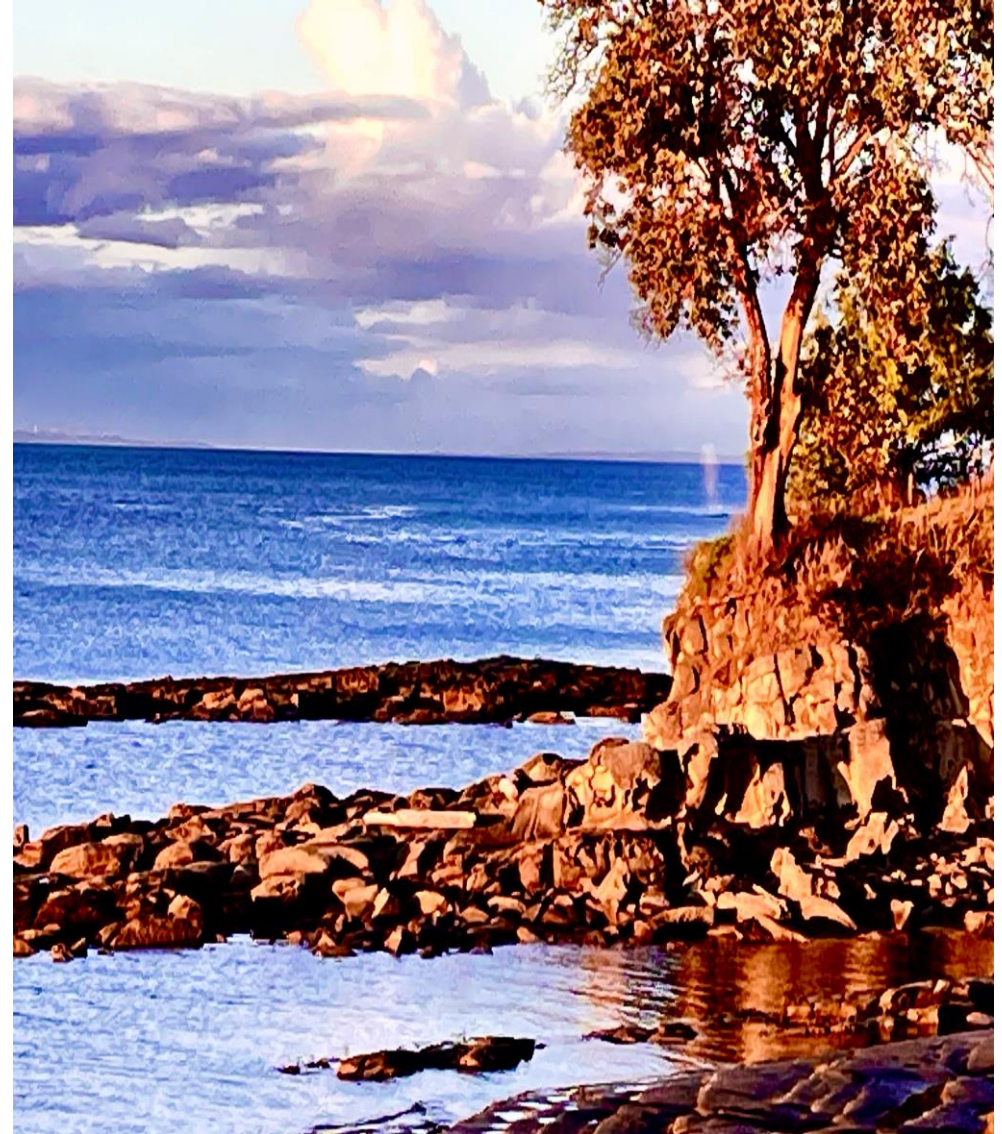

- Attractive and flexible APP contract with Island Health (full time or part time)
- Additional relocation and rural retention benefits, additional MSP Chronic Care Billings
- 38 paid locum days through the Rural Locum Service and MOCAP remuneration (on call: one day a week and one weekend per month),
- Additional benefits: additional remuneration in accordance with the Rural Subsidiary Agreement (RSA); Recruitment Incentive, rural CME and more.



The Clinic is part of a constellation of dedicated services providing community and public health nursing, physio and massage therapy, chiropractic, mental health counselling, and lab collection. The Clinic has a Nurse Practitioner funding available, experienced RN and MOAs. BCAS Heli-Pad and Paramedic Station on-site, Water – Ambulance to Victoria.

You will have your own patient panel and a minimum annual contractual requirement of 1,680 hours per year or less if chosen. Clinic hours and workdays can be modified to suit your own availability and practice model. On-call duty is shared with colleagues on Pender and Galiano Islands.

Mayne Island

S,ƘƦAƘ (Mayne Island) is located within the traditional lands of the Coast Salish peoples. There are exceptional recreational opportunities; a close, friendly community and abundant marine and land wildlife. The island has an elementary school, modern daycare, library, grocery stores, gas station, restaurants, and concerts and festivals. There are excellent ferry(1.5 h) and sea-air (20 min) connections to both Victoria and Vancouver.
